

# Eau Claire County Parks Terms & Conditions

## Camping Policies and Rules

- ONE CAMPING UNIT (travel trailer, pickup camper, pop-up, or motorhome) allowed per site. Tents are limited to two per site. Tents must be set up within the perimeter of the campsite. Camping allowed on designated campsites only.
- CHECK IN/OUT TIME is 3pm. Check in before 3pm is acceptable only if the site is vacant.
- RESERVATIONS must be made for a minimum two nights/three nights if holiday weekend unless holiday is on Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday. Reservations must be made at least three days prior to first requested night by internet or in person at Parks & Forest Office in Altoona and Coon Fork Campground. Accepted payment by credit card, check or cash.
- CAMPSITE OCCUPANCY: A campsite may be occupied by a parent(s) with their dependent children and not more than two (2) guests; or a group of not more than six adult persons; or a juvenile group of any organization with at least one adult for every ten (10) juveniles).
- Electric fees will be charged whenever an electrical site is purchased regardless of electricity used.
- TWO VEHICLES limited per site. Registered campers must check in at campground office to receive two (2) camper courtesy parking passes for vehicles upon arrival. Campers with additional vehicles must park extra vehicles in campground office lot and are required to purchase a day pass.
- VISITORS must park in the campground office lot. If two vehicles are at the site, visitors are asked to vacate the park by 11pm.
- No day pass necessary if an Annual Vehicle Pass has been purchased.
- CAMPING NIGHTS may be extended by renewing site no later than 12 noon if site is available.
- REFUNDS are available for camping fees in the form of a promo code if requested 14 days or more BEFORE the first scheduled camping night. This does NOT include reservation or courtesy fees. If you wish to change your reservation, you must submit your change **5 DAYS** before the day of your reservation, and you will be allowed to move your camping date to a later available date within the current camping season. A **\$5.00 fee will be charged**.
- FIREWOOD from distances further than a 25-mile radius of Coon Fork or outside Eau Claire County is not allowed to be brought into the campground.
- BARRIER-FREE/ADA sites are available by reservation only.
- PETS are to be kept on leash, not more than 8 feet long and never left unattended. Pets are not allowed in picnic or beach areas. Pet owners are required to clean up after their pets.
- QUIET HOURS are between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. All visitors must leave the park before 11 p.m.
- GENERATORS are not allowed during quiet times 10 p.m. - 7 a.m.
- PERSON WHO IS REGISTERED TO CAMPSITE will be held accountable for conduct at campsite.
- PERSONS AND/OR PARTIES CAMPING MAY CAMP A MAXIMUM OF 14 CONSECUTIVE NIGHTS then have to vacate all county parks and county properties for seven (7) consecutive nights before returning. In addition, parties may not move to another site, on forest lands, county campgrounds, or re-register under a different name.
