

Welcome to Coon Fork Campground

First and foremost, we thank you for choosing Coon Fork Campground as your vacation designation.

All campsites must be reserved before you can occupy the site.

If you have already registered for a site, please go to your site. Please check that the registration slip is in your name on the campsite marker.

If the office is closed and you didn't register online, please fill out a Camping Self Registration form for a MAX of Two Nights.

The white copy goes onto your campsite marker, the yellow and red copies are for your vehicles and the bottom copy is for your payment. Please place payment in the paybox.

Please adhere to the following campground policies

***Max Capacity is two tents per site or one camper and one tent per site.**

***Max Occupancy – A campsite may be occupied by a parent(s) with their dependent children and not more than two guests: or a group of not more than six adults.** A juvenile group of any organization with an adult for every 10 juveniles.

*** Check in/ Check out time is 3pm.** Campsites must be re-registered by no later than 12pm on departure day.

***Only two vehicles allowed per site.** No parking on the side of the road is allowed. Additional vehicles must park in the designated office parking lot and purchase a daily or annual pass.

***Visitors must purchase a Day or Annual pass to enter campground. All visitors must leave at 11pm.**

***Please keep sites clear of litter and debris.**

***Tree and brush cutting is not permitted.** There is firewood available for sale at the campground office during office hours.

***Maximum stay allowed is 14 consecutive nights per visit.** You must vacate EC County Parks/ Forest Land for 7 nights before you may return.

***Quiet Time is 10pm till 7am.** Please do not use generators during this timeframe.

***All off road vehicles such as UTV/ ATV, Golf Carts, Dirt Bikes, Go Carts are prohibited in the Park System.** Class 1 Electric bikes and electric scooters are allowed.

***All pets must be tied to a leash not longer than 8ft. Pets cannot be left unattended. Pets are not allowed in Picnic or Beach areas.** Infractions may result in a citation written out to the site holder.

***Barking dogs- Please do your best to limit your dog/s from excessively barking.** If complaints are noted, you may be notified to take your dog home or to vacate your campsite at the owners' expense.

***Firewood from a distance greater than 25 miles is not permitted.**

***Generators are allowed to be run during non-quiet times but cannot exceed 60dbd from 50ft.**

***Fireworks are not allowed within the Eau Claire County Parks system.**

***Disruptive Behavior, Theft, Drug Use and Vandalism will not be tolerated and will result in Law Enforcement Notification and eviction of parties involved at owner's expense. The person registered will be held accountable for conduct at the campsite.**
